Processed Fruits and Vegetables- The canned corn market remains relatively soft. Inventories are more than sufficient for today's business and are expected to carry into the production season next summer. The average fancy canned whole kernel corn price for 2006 is projected at \$12.35 per case, 10.5% less than last year.
